

Milwaukee Kilbourn Landing Project

The purpose of the Kilbourn Landing Public Access Project, located along the Milwaukee River, was to remediate contamination at and improve an important public access point at Kilbourn Park near downtown Milwaukee.

The Kilbourn Landing project included grading a high bluff to provide a connection from a hilltop urban neighborhood to the waterfront landing. The bluff known as Kilbourn Park received landscaping, trail development, and a bike path in a former rail corridor. The development also includes a riverfront viewing terrace, boat storage facility, floating dock and a riverfront plaza.

These capital improvements along the Commerce Street corridor, demonstrate how an urban community can successfully revitalize their waterfront areas.
